AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SETTLEMENT OF CERTAIN CLAIMS UNDER THE  
TORT CLAIMS ACT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 258 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended in the first paragraph by striking out in the  
3 second sentence the words "or after six months have passed from  
4 the date upon which such claim was presented to him."

1 SECTION 2. Section one of this act shall apply to dispositions  
2 entered on and after its effective date.
