AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF MANSFIELD AS THE JOHN D. PRESCOTT BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The bridge numbered M-3-31 on Barnes Boulevard (Rt. 140)
2 over state highway Route 495 in Mansfield shall be designated
3 and known as the John D. Prescott Bridge. Suitable markers
4 bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by the
5 department of public works in compliance with the standards of
6 said department.
