2 to sit during the session and recess of the General Court for the  
3 purpose of making an investigation and study of the current  
4 House document 4202, relative to voter registration sessions at  
5 recreational areas.

6     Said committee shall report the results of its investigation and  
7 study, and its recommendations, if any, to the General Court,  
8 together with the drafts of legislation to carry such recommenda-  
9 tions into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the House  
10 of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in December,  
11 nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
