The committee on Human Services and Elderly Affairs, to whom were recommitted so much of the recommendations of the Executive Office of Elder Affairs (House, No. 105) as relates to regulating the sale of leases in life care communities or continuing care retirement communities, so-called (accompanied by bill, House, No. 108), the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3711) of Sherwood Guernsey and another relative to continuing care retirement communities, and to whom was referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 561) of Andrew Collaro for legislation to establish a central Massachusetts Soldiers Home on the grounds of the Worcester State Hospital, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 6238) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Human Services and Elderly
2 Affairs be authorized to sit during the current session and during
3 the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an
4 investigation and study of current House documents 108 and 3711,
5 relative to the regulation of life care communities; and current
6 House document 561, relative to the Massachusetts Soldier's
7 Home.

8 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State
9 House or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the
10 Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services
11 such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall
12 report to the General Court the results of its investigation and
13 study and its recommendations, if any, together with the drafts
14 of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect
15 by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
16 on or before the last Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred
17 and eighty-seven.
