AN ACT AUTHORIZING JOHN HANNON TO BECOME AN OFFICER OF THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section nine A of chapter
2 twenty-two of the General Laws or any other general or special
3 law to the contrary, regulating the maximum age for enlistment
4 as an officer of the division of state police John Hannon shall be
5 eligible for enlistment as an officer in said division of state police,
6 according to the grade he received in the examination for state
7 policeman held on August twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and
8 eighty-seven, provided he meets all other requirements.
