AN ACT TO PROVIDE INCREASED PROTECTION FOR CONSUMERS IN SECURITIES AND COMMODITIES TRANSACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 93A of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting in clause (b) after the word "mixed", the following
- 3 words: — , and any security as defined in section 401K of chapter
- 4 110A of the General Laws.
