AN ACT RELATIVE TO OPTOMETRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 73B of Chapter 112, as appearing in the 1984 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking said section in its entirety
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 4 Section 73B (a) the Board shall make no rule or regulation
- 5 prohibiting licensees from practicing on the premises of a
- 6 commercial or mercantile establishment, including the premises
- 7 where eyeglasses or contact lenses are sold.
- 8 (b) No licensee may make a payment to any person in exchange
- 9 for the referral of a patient. Provided, however, that a licensee
- 10 may lawfully pay for any legal business service, whether computed
- 11 on a percentage of gross revenues basis or otherwise.
