### AN ACT PROHIBITING TYPED OR COMPUTERIZED MESSAGES BY TELEPHONE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1   Whoever, by means of a telephone, transmits a taped or
- 2   computerized message to a non-commercial telephone shall be
- 3   punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars or by
- 4   imprisonment in a jail or house of correction for not more than
- 5   six months, or both.
