

SENATE No. 341

By Mr. Bertonazzi (by request), a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 341) of Ross Rajotte for legislation to memorialize the Congress of the United States to change the formula for determining certain Social Security benefits for those born during the "Notch years", so-called. Federal Financial Assistance.

AN ACT MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO CHANGE THE FORMULA FOR CERTAIN SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Congress of the United States is hereby requested to amend
- 2 the formula used to calculate the benefits for the Notch years —
- 3 those born between 1917 and 1921 — to eliminate inequities
- 4 created by changes made in the Social Security Law in 1977.
