AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE ROLE OF THE MASTER PLUMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 142, Section 1, is further amended by adding a sentence
2 to the definition of "Master plumber" as follows: "A Master
3 plumber may also employ journeyman and apprentice gas fitters to
4 work at gas fitting."

5 Chapter 142 is further amended by deleting the last word "only"
6 from the second sentence in paragraph 2 of Section 3A and adding,
7 "or a Master plumber."
