### AN ACT PERTAINING TO THE SALE OF WINE AND MALT BEVERAGES..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 15 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by Chapter 351 of the Acts of 1981, is hereby further  
3 amended by adding after the second sentence the following: — “No  
4 person, firm, corporation, association, or other combination of  
5 persons, directly or indirectly, or through any agent, employee  
6 stockholder, officer or other person or any subsidiary whatsoever,  
7 shall be granted, in the aggregate, more than ten such wine and malt  
8 beverage licenses in the Commonwealth”.

THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN LIBRARY

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN LIBRARY

Section 1. The University of Michigan Library shall be organized and shall have the following powers and duties:

1. To acquire, collect, and preserve books, manuscripts, and other printed or written materials.
2. To acquire, collect, and preserve maps, charts, and other graphical materials.
3. To acquire, collect, and preserve records, documents, and other printed or written materials.
4. To acquire, collect, and preserve photographs, drawings, and other graphical materials.
5. To acquire, collect, and preserve sound recordings, motion pictures, and other audio-visual materials.
6. To acquire, collect, and preserve electronic materials.
7. To acquire, collect, and preserve any other materials that may be deemed to be in the best interests of the University.
