RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION TO STUDY SURPLUS STATE PROPERTIES FOR CONVERSION TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three
2 members of the house of representatives is hereby established for
3 the purpose of identifying surplus state properties and to establish
4 a program in order to examine and to study the feasibility of
5 creating, developing or converting said properties to affordable
6 housing for citizens of the commonwealth.

7 Said commission shall report its findings to the senate no later
8 than June first, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
