## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS AND TOXIC WASTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21C of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
- 2 ing after section 7 the following section: —
- 3 Section 7A. Every person, company, research institute or labo-
- 4 ratory that generates hazardous or toxic waste shall register with
- 5 the clerk of the city or town in which he or it is located. The
- 6 registration information shall include the name and address of
- 7 such individual or company and the types and amounts of hazard-
- 8 ous and toxic waste generated. Clerks of cities and towns shall
- 9 forward such information to the department. The department
- 10 shall record the type of hazardous or toxic wastes and the intended
- 11 method of disposal by the use of a computer. Each registrant shall
- 12 notify the department of the time of departure of such hazardous
- 13 or toxic waste from its facility and the time of arrival of such waste
- 14 at the disposal site.
