SENATE No. 1054

By Mr. Wetmore, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1054) of Joseph F. Murray and Robert D. Wetmore for legislation relative to the discharge of wastewater or sewerage into the waters of the Commonwealth. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISCHARGE OF WASTEWATER OR SEWERAGE
INTO THE WATERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no
- 2 wastewater or sewerage shall be discharged into any body of water
- 3 until it has a neutral bacterial and chemical reading.

By the Senate a resolution was passed by the yeas and nays, 18 yeas and 12 nays, to the effect that the Senate do pass the bill for the relief of the said [Name] and his heirs, and that the same be reported to the Senate with the usual recommendation.

The Amendment to the Bill

It is the sense of the Senate that the said bill be amended so as to read as follows:

AN ACT to amend the act in relation to the relief of the said [Name] and his heirs, and to amend the act in relation to the relief of the said [Name] and his heirs.
