AN ACT REQUIRING REPORTS OF VISION IMPAIRMENT TO THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 A physician, surgeon, optometrist, ophthalmologist or other  
2 person licensed to practice medicine or optometry who examines  
3 or treats the eye of a patient shall, if such patient has an  
4 impairment of vision which would inhibit the ability of such  
5 patient to safely operate a motor vehicle, report the name of such  
6 patient to the registrar of motor vehicles, including the nature of  
7 such impairment.
