AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE INSPECTION OF TRACTORS, TRAILERS, SEMI-TRAILERS, SEMI-TRAILER UNITS AND TANDEM UNITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The first paragraph of section 7A of chapter 90 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by chapter 139 of the acts of 1985, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following sentence: — The registrar shall  
5 establish rules and regulations providing for a periodic annual  
6 staggered safety and combined safety and emissions inspection of  
7 all motor vehicles, including tractors, trailers, semi-trailers, semi-  
8 trailer units and tandem units; provided, however that  
9 motorcycles, diesel powered vehicles, motor vehicles more than  
10 fifteen model years old before the date of inspection, and motor  
11 vehicles not capable of a speed greater than twenty-five miles per  
12 hour under any condition of operation or loading on a level  
13 surface shall be exempt from such emissions inspection but shall  
14 be subject to such safety inspection, and such vehicle shall be  
15 inspected for excessive smoke emissions, as provided in section  
16 sixteen.
