AN ACT AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR ACCUMULATED SICK AND VACATION LEAVE TO RETIRING JUSTICES OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 General Laws Chapter 211B section 4, as most recently amended
2 by Section 1984, Chapter 339, is hereby further amended by insert-
3 ing the following paragraph at the end thereof: —

4 Any justice who retires and who has accumulated sick leave
5 credits shall be paid an amount equal to twenty percent of the value
6 of such credits computed by multiplying the number of days of
7 accumulated sick leave available times the daily rate of salary
8 compensation received by the justice at the time of his retirement,
9 provided, however that such payment for unused sick leave shall
10 not affect the amount of retirement allowance available to such
11 justice.

12 Any justice who retires and who has accumulated vacation leave
13 credits shall be paid an amount equal to the value of such credits,
14 not to exceed thirty days, computed by multiplying the number of
15 accumulated vacation leave available times the daily rate of salary
16 compensation, provided, however, that such payment for unused
17 vacation leave shall not affect the amount of retirement allowance
18 available to such justice.
