

**SENATE . . . . . No. 1324**

By Mr. Bolling, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1324) of Royal L. Bolling, Sr., for legislation that net proceeds from the excise imposed upon deeds, instruments and writings in Suffolk County be distributed to the city of Boston. Taxation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE DEEDS EXCISE TO THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter sixty-  
2 four D of the General Laws, section eight A of chapter one  
3 hundred and ninety of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-  
4 two, and section twenty-three of chapter five hundred and forty-  
5 six of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, when the  
6 obligation of the state treasurer to pay the excise imposed by  
7 chapter sixty-four D to the city of Boston expires, in accordance  
8 with section eight A of chapter one hundred and ninety of the  
9 acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-two, the net proceeds from  
10 the excise imposed upon deeds, instruments, and writings in  
11 Suffolk County shall thereafter, on or before the last day of each  
12 calendar quarter, be distributed by the state treasurer upon the  
13 certification of the commissioner of revenue without further  
14 appropriation to the city of Boston to fund the costs of Suffolk  
15 County borne by said city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. Amounts received by the city of Boston under  
2 this act shall not be considered in the determination of the amount  
3 of any distribution of state assistance to said city.
