Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subdivision (b) of subsection B of section 3 of chapter 62 of
- 2 the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the following
- 3 paragraph: -
- 4 (7) An exemption equal to the amount of expenses paid by any
- 5 person for the purchase of commuter rail tickets issued by any 6 railroad within the commonwealth and/or a reasonable allowance
- 7 for expenses paid for fares on any of the rapid transit lines, where
- 8 applicable, or surface lines owned and operated by the MBTA
- 9 or any independent bus line and/or the amount of expenses paid
- 10 by any person as tolls for the use of the Massachusetts Turnpike
- 11 Authority system.
