AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF LISA FAY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation
2 of the department of public welfare and of the secretary of human
3 services, Lisa Fay, a severely handicapped person residing in the
4 city of Boston, a recipient under the social security laws of the
5 United States government, shall be continuously eligible to receive
6 medicaid benefits from the commonwealth of Massachusetts
7 notwithstanding the fact that she is employed on a full-time or
8 part-time basis.
