AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE LIQUOR LIABILITY JUA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 223 of the Acts of 1985 is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new
3 sentence: — The joint underwriting authority may recommend to
4 the Commissioner that a system of premium surcharges and credits
5 based upon claim frequency and loss experience be established.

1 SECTION 2. Section 8 of Chapter 223 of the Acts of 1985 is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words “thirteen directors” in
3 lines one and two and inserting in place thereof: — “fifteen
4 directors.”

1 SECTION 3. Said section 8 of chapter 223 as so stated is further
2 amended by striking out the word “Four” in line five and inserting
3 in place thereof the word “Six.”

4 The provisions of this section shall not be construed so as to alter
5 or amend the terms of the present governing board.

1 SECTION 4. Chapter 223 of the Acts of 1985 is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 13 and inserting in place thereof the follow-
3 ing: —

4 Section 13. Section one to twelve, inclusive, of this act shall
5 expire on December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
