AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AMBULANCE PLATES FOR MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED TO RECOGNIZED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION OF HUMAN ORGANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out the definition "Ambulance" and inserting in place
3 thereof the following definition: —

4 "Ambulance", a motor vehicle equipped and used exclusively for
5 the transportation of sick, injured or wounded persons, or a motor
6 vehicle registered to a recognized nonprofit organization and used
7 exclusively for the emergency transportation of human organs, or a
8 motor vehicle operated by a society incorporated under the laws of
9 the commonwealth for the prevention of cruelty to animals, or for
10 the care and protection of harmless or suffering animals, and used
11 exclusively for the transportation of stray and neglected, sick,
12 injured or wounded animals.
