RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF THE WIDOW OF THE LATE PHILIP J. PHILBIN.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of promoting the public good,
2 and after an appropriation has been made therefor, there shall
3 be paid out of the state treasury to the widow of the late Philip
4 J. Philbin, who died while serving as clerk of courts of the superior
5 court department in the county of Worcester, the salary to which
6 he would have been entitled had he lived and served until the end
7 of the calendar year nineteen hundred and eighty-seven. The
8 additional benefits provided for by this resolve shall be included
9 as regular compensation for Philip J. Philbin for the purposes of
10 computing his retirement benefits pursuant to chapter thirty-two
11 of the General Laws.
