## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SOUTH ESSEX SEWERAGE DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of Section 2 of Chapter  
2 339 of the Acts of 1925 as appearing in Section 3 of Chapter 643  
3 of the Acts of 1972, is hereby amended by deleting the last two  
4 sentences thereof and replacing it with the following:

5 He shall be chairman of said board. Each of the other members  
6 of said board shall receive from said district, in addition to any  
7 compensation from any other source, such annual compensation,  
8 not exceeding one thousand five hundred dollars, as the governor  
9 may from time to time determine. The chairman of said board  
10 shall receive from said district such annual compensation, not  
11 exceeding twice the amount of compensation provided to the  
12 other members of said board, as the governor may from time to  
13 time determine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
