SENATE, June 23, 1987.

1 *Ordered*, That the Rules of the Senate be amended by insert-  
2 ing the following new Rule: —

3 Rule 7D. No bill reported by the Senate committee on Ways  
4 and Means making appropriations for the expenses of the Com-  
5 monwealth shall contain any provisions on any other subject. As  
6 used in this paragraph expenses of the Commonwealth shall  
7 include the expenses of the executive, legislative, and judicial  
8 departments, interest, payments on the public debt, local aid, and  
9 other expenses authorized or required by existing laws.

10 This rule shall not be suspended if objection is made.
