AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF FAIRHAVEN TO APPOINT THE COLLECTOR OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of
2 chapter forty-one of the General Laws, or of any other general
3 or special law, the Selectmen of the Town of Fairhaven shall
4 appoint a suitable person, who need not be a citizen of the town,
5 Collector of Taxes, for a term of not more than three years and
6 may remove him at any time for cause after a hearing. Upon the
7 taking of oath of such person so appointed the term of existing
8 Collector of Taxes shall terminate.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
