AN ACT VALIDATING THE PROPOSITION TWO AND ONE-HALF EXEMPTION VOTE FOR CERTAIN LIBRARY BONDS TO BE ISSUED BY THE TOWN OF WEST NEWBURY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The action taken by the town of West Newbury  
2 by the vote taken on May fifth, nineteen hundred and eighty-six  
3 to exempt from the annual tax limitations of section twenty-one  
4 C of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws on bonds to be issued  
5 to enlarge, renovate and furnish the G.A.R. Memorial Library  
6 is hereby ratified, validated, and confirmed, notwithstanding any  
7 defect or omission in the calling of the election.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
