The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE
MILITARY DIVISION OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws is hereby amended in the definition of Group
3 4, as most recently amended by sections 84 and 85 of chapter 706
4 of the acts of 1975, by inserting after "based upon federal
5 recognition in the Massachusetts National Guard," the
6 following: — and those officers of the military forces of the
7 commonwealth employed under sections 15 and 18 of chapter 33
8 of the General Laws.

9 This civil mission is directed by law and is well recognized by
10 local and state law enforcement authorities as evidenced by the
11 identification of the Military Division by the Secretary of Public
12 Safety as a "Priority 1" agency, having "a direct emergency or law
13 enforcement responsibility to the public."

14 The affected individuals are, by virtue of their positions, officers
15 of the military forces of the Commonwealth, and, as such, are
16 subject to 24-hour duty, seven days a week, without any right to
17 overtime pay or compensatory time. They may at any time be
18 ordered into law enforcement activities as part of their official
19 duties.

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
