AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL ALLOWANCES TO ORGANIZATIONS AND UNITS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 out section 97, as most recently amended by chapter 370 of the  
3 acts of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —  
4 Section 97. There shall be allowed and paid quarterly from  
5 money appropriated for the purpose in such amounts and at such  
6 times as may be determined by the adjutant general pursuant to  
7 such regulations as may be promulgated by the commander-in-  
8 chief, to the organizations and units of the armed forces of the  
9 commonwealth, when not in federal service, for administration  
10 and maintenance, including postage, printing, office and other  
11 necessary supplies not available through issue, for athletic or  
12 recreational equipment for the use of enlisted personnel, for the  
13 repair and alteration of uniforms, and such other military pur-  
14 poses as may be approved by the commander-in-chief in said  
15 regulations.
