AN ACT MAKING A TECHNICAL CHANGE REGARDING THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The seventh paragraph of section 9 of chapter 12A of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence
3 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Such
4 summons shall be served by the inspector general or anyone duly
5 authorized by him, in the same manner as a summons for the
6 production of documents in civil cases issued on behalf of the
7 commonwealth, and all provisions of law relative to said summons
8 shall apply to a summons issued pursuant to this chapter.
