The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO REIMBURSE CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the department of public works is
3 hereby authorized and directed to reimburse from any available
4 funds, Ralph E. Gurney, Jr. of the town of Freetown, the sum
5 of one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven dollars and thirty-
6 two cents for costs incurred in drilling a new water supply well
7 in March, nineteen hundred and eighty-four to replace a salt
8 contaminated well.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the department of public works is
3 hereby authorized and directed to reimburse from any available
4 funds, Robert Goyette of the town of Scituate, the sum of four
5 thousand eight hundred twenty-five dollars and zero cents for
6 costs incurred in installing a water line and connecting the
7 residence to a public water supply in December, nineteen hundred
8 and eighty-five to replace a salt contaminated well.
