AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSTRUCTIONS FOR GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 53 of chapter 15 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by section 6 of chapter 188 of the acts 1985, is hereby
3 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

4 Each public school district shall provide a program of instruc-
5 tion for gifted and talented students in the elementary, middle and
6 high school levels. Such programs must meet the approval of the
7 office for the gifted and talented.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon it acceptance by
2 any city or town.
