RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE BUREAU OF TRANSITIONAL PLANNING.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of
3 representatives, and three persons to be appointed by the governor
4 one of whom shall be a member of the immediate family of a
5 disable person as defined in section twelve A of chapter seventy-
6 one B of the General Laws, is hereby established for the purpose
7 of making an investigation and study relative to the provision of
8 services to disabled persons by the bureau of transitional planning
9 and the allocation of funds to area offices and clients.

10 Said commission shall report to the general court the results
11 of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,
12 together with drafts or legislation to carry its recommendations
13 into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
14 representatives on or before the first Wednesday in November,
15 nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
