AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PUBLIC INSPECTION OF CERTAIN JUVENILE COURT RECORDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 60A of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out  
3 the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 paragraph: —

5 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the name of a  
6 child shall be made available to the public by the probation officer  
7 without such consent if the child is alleged to have committed an  
8 offense while between his fourteenth and seventeenth birthdays  
9 if such child has been previously alleged to have committed an  
10 offense notwithstanding the disposition of the previous offense.
