

HOUSE No. 626

By Mr. Trombley of Waltham, petition of Peter G. Trombley that certain pleasure passenger motor vehicles be authorized to display only one plate. Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PLEASURE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES NEED DISPLAY ONLY ONE NUMBER PLATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1984
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out section 6B and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 4 Section 6B. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
- 5 special law or any rule or regulation to the contrary, the registrar
- 6 shall issue only one number plate, instead of two, for pleasure
- 7 passenger motor vehicles and he may issue either one or two
- 8 number plates for other motor vehicles. Where only one number
- 9 plate is so issued by the registrar such plate shall be displayed at
- 10 the rear of the vehicle for which it is issued, and all consistent
- 11 provisions of law or of rules and regulations relating to number
- 12 plates shall apply to such plate.
