AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A COST OF LIVING INCREASE FOR CERTAIN RETIREES AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding so much of the provisions of section one
2 hundred and two of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws as
3 pertains to the comparison determined by the life actuary in the
4 division of insurance, but in all other respects subject to the
5 provisions of said section one hundred and two of said chapter
6 thirty-two, the retirement allowance, pension or annuity of every
7 former employee of the Commonwealth or of any county, city,
8 town, district, housing or redevelopment authority, of the Mas-
9 sachusetts Port Authority, the Blue Hills Regional Vocational
10 School system, the Greater Lawrence Sanitary District, the Min-
11 uteman Regional Vocational Technical School District or of the
12 spouse or other beneficiary of any such former employee who is
13 receiving a retirement allowance, pension or annuity pursuant to
14 said chapter shall, beginning July first of nineteen hundred and
15 eighty-eight be increased by five percent.
