AN ACT PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS TO CERTAIN VIETNAM VETERANS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 601 of the Acts of 1966 is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 4, as amended by section 4 of chapter 716 of the acts
3 of 1983, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
4 Section 4. The board of regents shall establish policies regarding
5 tuition waivers and exhaustion of federal educational benefits for
6 Vietnam veterans which shall be consistent for all such veterans,
7 whether enrolled in full-time or part-time continuing education
8 courses or university extension courses; provided, however, that
9 said policies shall apply also to Vietnam veterans who did not
10 enter the service from the Commonwealth, but who have resided
11 for two consecutive years in the Commonwealth immediately
12 prior to their application for or receipt of tuition benefits for which
13 they shall be deemed qualified. Each such veteran shall file a sworn
14 affidavit as to such residency.
