RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND THEIR ACTIVITIES IN POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the Senate, six members of the House of
3 Representatives and two persons to be appointed by the
4 Governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an
5 investigation and study relative to employees of the Common-
6 wealth and their activities in political campaigns.

7 Said commission shall report to the House of Representatives
8 the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
9 if any, together with drafts of legislation necesary to carry its
10 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of
11 the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday
12 in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.
