AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT CLERKS IN THE CENTRAL DISTRICT COURT OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in line 74, the words: — central district court of
4 Worcester.

1 SECTION 2. Section 10 of said chapter 218 is hereby further
2 amended by inserting after the ninth paragraph the following
3 paragraph: —
4 Eleven assistant clerks with salaries payable by the common-
5 wealth may be appointed in central district court of Worcester.
