AN ACT RELATIVE TO INCREASING THE COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENTS FOR RETIRED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 102 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the words "seven thousand dollars"
- 3 wherever they appear and inserting thereof the words: — nine
- 4 thousand dollars.
