AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REDEMPTION OF TAX TITLE PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 68 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws as so appearing
- 2 in the Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out in lines
- 3 5 and 6 the following words: — “may in any case in its discretion”
- 4 and by inserting in place thereof the word: — shall.
