AN ACT REQUIRING HOUSING AUTHORITIES TO PROVIDE SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION TO DISABLED RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32 of Chapter 121 B, as most recently amended by St.
2 1981, ch. 510., is hereby amended by adding the following new
3 section 32B.

4 Section 32B (a) Housing Authorities shall be required to create
5 a special identification for all disabled residents so they may be
6 assisted in an emergency which would necessitate quick escape
7 from the building. This identification shall be displayed in a place
8 evident to emergency assistance personnel. Housing Authorities
9 shall also be required to provide to emergency assistance person-
10 nel, a floor plan showing which apartments or rooms are inhabited
11 by disabled residents.

12 (b) "Disabled resident" here shall mean any person either
13 restricted to a wheelchair or otherwise disabled in any way that
14 may restrict their efforts to escape.
