AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN TRANSPORTATION COSTS AND THEIR PAYMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The costs of transportation of any public school child in any
2 city or town pursuant to a program for children with special needs
3 is established and maintained under the provisions of chapter
4 seventy-one B of the General Laws shall be borne equally between
5 the department of education and the department of
6 transportation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That
