AN ACT AUTHORIZING MARILYN SULLIVAN TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize Marilyn
3 Sullivan to take a civil service examination for police officer
4 notwithstanding the maximum age requirement, therefore it is
5 hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
6 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
2 or rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant
3 for an appointment as a police officer, Marilyn Sullivan of the
4 town of Randolph shall be eligible to take the next open
5 competitive examination for appointment to the position of police
6 officer, and provided she meets all other requirements, shall be
7 eligible for certification and appointment to such position.
