### AN ACT LIMITING THE TAKING OF PHOTOGRAPHS IN CEMETERIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 42B of chapter 114 of the General Laws as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 415 of the Acts of 1970 is hereby amended  
3 by striking out the first sentence contained therein and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following: — “No person shall use the premises  
5 of a cemetery or burial place for the purpose of taking any  
6 photograph or motion picture without first have obtained the  
7 consent of the board of commissioners, trustees or directors of  
8 said cemetery.”
