By Mr. Giordano of Methuen, petition of Larry F. Giordano and Thomas G. Palumbo that provision be made for mandatory imprisonment for second convictions for breaking and entering in the day time or night time. Criminal Justice.

AN ACT PROVIDING A MANDATORY IMPRISONMENT SENTENCE FOR THE SECOND CONVICTION FOR BREAKING AND ENTERING IN THE DAY TIME OR NIGHT TIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 19 the following section: —
- 3 Section 19A. Whoever having been convicted of any of the
- 4 offenses set forth in sections fourteen to nineteen, inclusive, shall
- 5 upon a second conviction thereof, receive the maximum sentence
- 6 provided for in his last conviction, whether such offense was
- 7 committed in the day time or night time, and such sentence shall
- 8 not be suspended.
