AN ACT CLARIFYING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3L of Chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the following new paragraph:
4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the
5 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority as defined by
6 Chapter 161A of the General Laws, shall be exempt from the
7 permit and inspection requirements for energizing new and
8 modified electric service and no electric utility regulated by the
9 Department of Public Utilities under Chapter 164 of the General
10 Laws shall require such permit prior to energizing such service.
11 This exemption shall apply only to work performed by the
12 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority and its employees
13 and shall not apply to any vendors and/or contractors of said
14 Authority.
