AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE ENDS WITH THE REMARRIAGE OF THE FORMER SPOUSE OF A GROUP MEMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 110I of chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out subsection (b) as appearing in chapter
3 735 of the acts of 1981, and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing subsection: —

5 (b) In the event of the remarriage of the group plan member
6 referred to in subsection (a), the former spouse shall not have the
7 right to continue such benefits under the plan.
