AN ACT TO IMPROVE SERVICE AND REDUCE WAITING LINES AT THE  
REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 in Section 1A the following: —
- 3 The Registry of Motor Vehicles shall issue registrations to all
- 4 commercial vehicles, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, semi-trailers
- 5 and tractors so that the expiration of said registrations is staggered
- 6 over the entire twelve months of the year rather than having all
- 7 of the above-mentioned registrations expire on the same date each
- 8 year.
