By Mr. Grenier of Spencer, petition of Henry R. Grenier relative to reckless, unauthorized or drunken driving on the frozen surface of any body of water in the Commonwealth. Public Safety.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO RECKLESS, UNAUTHORIZED, DRUNKEN DRIVING IN CERTAIN PUBLIC AREAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph: —
- 3 For the purposes of this section any place to which the public
- 4 has a right of access or to which members of the public have access
- 5 as invitees or licensees shall include the frozen surface of any body
- 6 of water in the Commonwealth.
